

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Take a moment to review the terms and conditions for this event

These terms and conditions (these “Terms”) govern your registration for and participation in the 2026 Grants Compliance Administration Conference (the “Event”) and are an agreement between Region 16 Education Service Center (“Region 16,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) and you. You represent to us that you are authorized to enter into these Terms.

EVENT. You may only register for and attend the Event in accordance with these Terms. To register for the Event, you must complete the Event registration process. Sharing your registration with another person(s) is a violation of the Code of Conduct and may result in your access to the event being terminated and/or denied.

HEALTH AND SAFETY; ASSUMPTION OF RISK. By registering for this Event, you acknowledge the inherent risk of exposure to communicable diseases, including but not limited to COVID-19 and seasonal influenza, which may exist in any public place where people are present.

You voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to such diseases and agree that Region 16 ESC, the host venue, and their respective officers and employees are not liable for any illness or injury that may result from your attendance. You agree to comply with all health and safety protocols posted at the venue or mandated by Texas state and local authorities at the time of the Event. In accordance with Texas law, proof of vaccination will not be required for entry.

You acknowledge that this action constitutes an 'opt-in' under the Texas Data Privacy and Security Act. You may revoke this consent at any time by contacting the industry partner directly. Region 16 is not responsible for the data processing practices of third-party exhibitors.

If necessary, conference staff are empowered to take appropriate actions that may include, but are not limited to, debarment from the conference without refund and/or involving venue security or local law enforcement.

The Terms and Conditions may be revised at any time by Region 16 and the terms are non-negotiable.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS. All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to t1pfe@esc16.net.

- **Full Refund:** Cancellations received before October 16, 2026 will receive a full refund, less a \$50 administrative processing fee.
- **50% Refund:** Cancellations received between October 17 and October 27, 2026 at 11:59 PM CST will receive a 50% refund, less a \$50 administrative processing fee.
- **No Refunds:** Cancellations received after October 28, 2026 at 11:59 PM CST, as well as "no-shows," are not eligible for a refund.
- **Substitutions:** You may transfer your registration to another individual from your organization at no additional cost. Substitution requests must be submitted in writing no later than October 28, 2026 at 11:59PM CST.
